Below you will find SEL lead times and information regarding ordering from our POD catalog. Please keep in mind that lead do not begin until a formal Purchase Order has been received. These times are for artwork production only and do not include framing time.

Transit time and holidays are not included.

Lead-Time Schedule

POD on paper	5 Business Days, 1 week
Unstretched Canvas	5 Business Days, 1 week
Stretched Canvas	10-15 Business Days, 2-3 weeks
Contract and Edge Framed Canvas	15 Business Days, 3 weeks
ALM/ACR/BAM/BIR/GLA	15-20 Business Days, 3-4 weeks
Dimensional Editions (DIM)	20-25 Business Days, 4-5 weeks
Sourced Imagery	Add 3 Business days to substrate Lead-time. This may qualify for an art consulting fee.
Custom Orders	Discuss with Production Team to confirm accuracy of custom order lead times.
Embellishments	<5 pieces, 2 Business Days PLUS production >5 pieces, 5 Business Days PLUS Production

RUSH Fee Schedule

Overview	Any request to ship an order prior to the alloted time requires approval. All fees are assigned per project and are based on specifications. Below are estimates only.
Fine Art Paper and Unstretched Canvas	\$25 per piece
Stretched Canvas	\$50 per piece
Contract and Edge Framed Canvas	\$50 per piece
ALM/ACR/BAM/BIR/GLA	\$25-\$50 per piece

Color Adjustment	\$50-\$100
Outside Image Licensing	Based on third party cost.
Embellishments (Gloss Coating with Brushstrokes, for flat gloss coating without brushstrokes subtract \$10)	Small: \$35 (<24"x24" OR <36" long side) Med: \$50 (<36x36" OR 48" long side) Large: \$65 (<48x48" OR 60" long side) X Large: \$75 (>48x48" OR 60"long side)
